Author of numerous essays and participations in a wide variety of areas of contemporary culture, from his body of work, the following books are mere highlights Analítica da Actualidade, Política e Modernidade, Traços. Ensaios sobre a Cultura Contemporânea, Teoria da Cultura, Síntese, Albuquerque Mendes ou o Ardor da Arte, Queda Sem Fim, Envios. Uma experimentação filosófica nos Blogues, Corpo e Imagem e Jorge Molder.

His latest book, Constelações: Ensaios sobre Técnica e Cultura na Contemporaneidade, will be launched at Documenta in February 2023. Since December 2022 he holds the office of Rector at Lusófona University.
